The Appeals, Writs, and Trials Section of the Criminal Law Division in Los Angeles ("LA AWT") is accepting applications from first-year day, second-year day and third-year evening or part-time students for law clerk positions. At various times our positions have been paid, work-study, and/or volunteer positions, depending upon our budget.

Law clerks in this section spend all of their time conducting legal research and writing in the areas of criminal law and procedure, constitutional law, and evidence.

Interviewed candidates will be required to submit the following items: (1) a current resume, (2) one writing sample, an appellate brief if possible, and (3) grade point information, with particular reference, if available, to course grades received in criminal law, criminal procedure, constitutional law, evidence, and legal research and writing. Applications will not be considered until all of the requested materials have been received. Reference letters are not required, but they may be extremely helpful in a particular case.
