


DEALERS RECORD OF SALE TRANSACTIONS

The following chart shows the total number of transactions processed by DOJ between 1972 and 2008. The impact of key legislation on firearms sales is highlighted.

NOTES

1972-1974: DOJ was required to notify dealers and law enforcement of prohibited firearms purchasers, but was unable to stop delivery because the waiting period was limited to 5 days.

1975-1997: 15-day waiting period in place.

1997-present: 10-day waiting period in place.

2000: Limit handgun purchases to 1 in a 30 day period.
