

## CLUB SAN RAFAEL CALIFORNIA-22

- 1) A shoe consists of six decks, each containing a joker which has a value of 1 or 11.
- 2) Players play against the banker.
- 3) At the beginning of play, the option to bank the game is offered to the players in rotation starting from the left of the dealer. The bank may be held for maximum of two hands. Thereafter, the option to bank continues to be offered in rotation to the left.
- 4) A player may bank with any amount of money, but can only win or lose the amount banked. Any amounts exceeding what is put up as a bank is covered by the next available bank in rotation.
- 5) Betting consists of a minimum of \$2 to a maximum of \$50.
- 6) A player may play up to 3 vacant spots.
- 7) Players are dealt two cards face up
- 8) Banker is dealt two cards in front of the dealer, one face up and one face down.
- 9) Starting with the player to the left of the dealer and rotating around the table, each player has the option to "hit" (take another card or cards) or "stay" (pass to the next player).
- 10) A natural 22 (two aces, two jokers, or a joker and an ace) wins and is paid immediately
- 11) If the player goes over 22, his hand is held until every hand at the table has played.
- 12) After all players have had the option to "hit" or "stay", the banker's hand is turned over
- 13) Banker must hit a Soft 18 or lower. Banker must stand on a Hard 18 or higher,
- 14) Hands that are closest to 22 without exceeding that number are winners.
- 15) If the banker goes over 22, any player having the exact same number as the banker receives a "push" and keeps his bet.
- 16) Players may split any pair once and may double down on an 11 or 12 received in the first two cards.
- 17) A wager equal to the original amount is required when splitting pairs.

18) A wager for less than the original amount is allowed when doubling down.

19) A player may not double down after splitting a pair.

19) The banker may not split pairs or double down.

20) California-22 is offered from 5:00 pm -2:00 pm Monday through Saturday.

## TEXAS HOLD'EM

In Texas Hold-Em each player receives two uninterrupted cards singly dealt face down as their initial hand. There is a round of betting after these cards have been delivered. Three board cards (called "the Flop") are now turned simultaneously face up in the center of the table and another round of betting occurs. The next two board cards are turned face up in the center of the table, one at a time with a round of betting after each card. These board-cards are community cards shared by all active players at the table. At completion of each hand each active player will have 7 cards, two personal and five community cards that are turned face-up in the center of the table. A player may use any combination of five cards (one in their hand, four from the board, etc.) to determine their best high hand.

Hold-Em uses a dealer button to indicate the player who in theory dealt the cards for that pot. The player with the dealer button is the last to receive cards on the initial deal and has the right of last-action on all betting rounds except the first. One or more blind bets are used to start the action and initiate play. Blinds are posted by the player who is on the button and the first player to the left of the button. Action is initiated on the first betting round by the player on the immediate of the last blind. On all subsequent betting rounds the action is begun by the first active player clockwise from the button. All blinds are considered to be live and if there are no raises, blinds may raise themselves when the action comes to them.

Texas Hold'em is offered from 7:00 pm - 2:00 am on Thursdays.

## OMAHA

In Omaha each player receives four uninterrupted cards dealt face down as their initial hand. A player must use two cards in their hand and three cards from the board to determine their best high hand. All other rules for Texas Hold-em apply.

Omaha is offered from 7:00 pm - 2:00 am on Mondays and Thursdays.

Method of collecting the drop at Club San Rafael ▪

Texas Hold'em and Omaha

The player with the button is the "small blind" and places one chip on the button. The player to his left is the "big blind" and places three chips in front of him/her. The dealer collects these two blinds and places them in front of the drop box before any cards are dealt. After the first three cards have been dealt the four chips are dropped into the box.

California 22

When placing a bet the player also places a collection fee in the designated circle in front of them. The amount of the collection fee is: for a bet of \$2 - \$20, the collection fee is **50¢**; for a bet of \$21 - \$50, the collection fee is \$1.00. (Minimum bet is \$2 and maximum is \$50)
