CU - 01	Calaveras County Sheriff's Department	Calaveras	The applicant is requesting to migrate from LEAWEB to a direct connect MSC as the County Control Agency and will be installing a new CAD system. One LEAWEB mnemonic will be maintained for backup purposes only.
CU - 02	California City Police Department	Kern	The applicant is requesting to use a microwave system to connect to the Kern County SO Message Switch. They are also seeking approval for their LAN environment and CAD system.
CU - 03	Chowchilla Police Department	Madera	The applicant currently accesses CLETS behind the Merced County Sheriff's Department's MSC. They will be adding a new CAD system that will connect to the Madera County Sheriff's Department's MSC.
CU - 04	Colton Police Department	San Bernardino	The applicant is requesting approval to pool mnemonics.
CU - 05	Concord Police Department	Contra Costa	The applicant is requesting approval to access CLETS via a Virtual Private Network (VPN) tunnel over the Internet for their wireless CLETS devices.
