CU - 01	Barstow Police Department	San Bernardino	The applicant is adding the CLIPS software package to facilitate CLETS access. Client is also adding 16 mobile terminals via Verizon wireless.
CU - 02	CA Administrative Office of the Courts - CCPOR	San Francisco	The applicant is: 1) Implementing an automated protective restraining order central repository in Tempe, Arizona, and 2) Implementing the CCPOR in a non-production environment (disaster recovery and testing) located in Omaha, Nebraska.
CU - 03	CA Administrative Office of the Courts - SAIC	San Francisco	The applicant is: 1) Moving the MSC from their current vendor in California to a new vendor in Tempe, Arizona, and 2) Moving the non-production portion (used for disaster recovery, testing, and staging) of the MSC to a new vendor in Omaha, Nebraska.
CU - 04	CA State Lottery, Law Enforcement Division	Sacramento	The applicant is requesting a CLETS direct connect and adding wireless connectivity and mnemonic pooling. They are also adding CLETS access conducted via MSC and CAD/RIMS.
