**INFORMATION:** The CSU Channel Islands Police Department is requesting assistance in identifying a suspect in an attempted kidnapping. Report # 07 - 1257

**MODUS OPERANDI SUMMARY:** On 10/15/07, around 10:35 P.M. the suspect drove up to a female student in a 2005 - 2006 black Ford Mustang. The student was attempting to get into her car at the CSU Channel Islands campus parking lot. He approached her asking for directions and then grabbed her from behind. He placed a box cutter knife to the victim's throat and attempted to pull her into his vehicle. The female student was able to free herself from the suspect, enter into her vehicle, and shut the door. When she looked back for the suspect, he had fled the scene.
