
SUSPECT: Unknown

PHYSICAL: Hispanic male; 5' 8"; medium weight; 30-35 years of age; short brown hair; brown eyes; clean shaven

CLOTHING: Black jacket; blue jeans

WEAPON: Box cutter

VEHICLE: Maroon/red, two-door with black interior and tinted windows



OUTSTANDING FEATURES: Fluent in English, but spoke with a Spanish accent

INFORMATION: The Los Angeles Sheriffs Department is requesting assistance in identifying a suspect in a kidnaping and sexual assault.

MODUS OPERANDI SUMMARY: On January 21, 2004, at 0615 hours, a kidnaping and sexual assault occurred, at a bus stop, at the intersection of Garvey Avenue and Muscatel Avenue, in the city of Rosemead. The female victim was walking to the San Gabriel High School bus stop when she observed above suspect standing next to his vehicle parked in the alley near the bus stop. As the victim passed, the suspect rushed up behind her, pulled out a box cutter, put it to her neck and pushed the victim inside his vehicle. Suspect proceeded to drive around the area for the next 45 minutes on both residential streets and the freeway while assaulting the victim. Suspect apologized and drove the victim back to school and dropped her off.
